

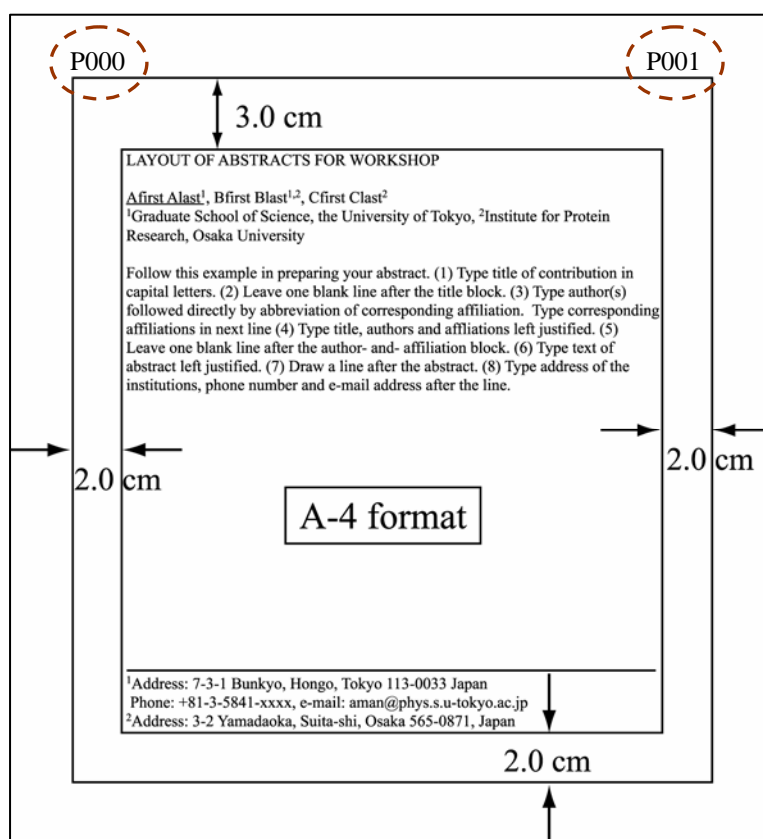
Style, Layout and Format of Abstracts and Submittal Information

Abstract Instructions

Abstracts are limited to one page. Abstracts must be electronically prepared using **Times or Times New Roman fonts** (except for symbols) on A-4 format (21 cm ×29.7 cm) with 3.0-cm top margins, and 2.0-cm bottom, right and left margins. Tables, graphics, figures and images may be included, but **must be electronically transmittable as a part of the text document and require no additional software to reproduce** (An inserted file with popular formats such as TIFF and JPEG are preferred for graphics, figures and images). The size of the file should be less than 500 kbytes.

Abstracts should be written in **English**, and include title, authors (first, middle initial and last names), affiliations, abstract text, address of the institution(s), and e-mail address, all of which should be left justified. Title must be in capital letters, bold type, 14-point. The other parts must be in 12-point, plain type. Title, authors and affiliations should be at the top of the page. Please underline the presenting author. The address of institution(s) and the e-mail address should be

written at the bottom of the page. The poster number should be written at the top left side for even poster number or the top right side for odd number. The poster number must be in capital letters, 16-point. An example of the abstract is shown:



Abstracts will appear in the Book of Abstracts exactly as submitted. Authors are requested to follow strictly the above instructions.

For preparing Index of Authors of the Book of Abstracts, authors are asked to fill a Microsoft Excel file that is sent as an attached file (filename is "sakuin.xls"). This file requires information on the authors , corresponding affiliations (in English) and poster number. Please fill the information shown above according to examples found in the attached file.

The deadline of abstract submission is on October 27, 2006.

Please attach your abstract as PDF file with the file named as "PosterNumber.doc(for example, P000.doc)" and the Excel file written above with the same name as the abstract file (for example, P000.xls).
