Presenters' Information

Oral presentation

- 1. All rooms will be equipped with an LCD projector and an official laptop PC. Each oral presenter is asked to connect her/his laptop PC to the LCD projector (with an analog D-sub 15 pins connector) prior to the session or during break. Please make sure that your PCs are not infected with computer viruses. The official PC contains Microsoft Windows 7 (Japanese version) and MS PowerPoint 2013 on which only the powerpoint file (.ppt or .pptx format) can be played. In order to minimize technical troubles of software, oral presenters are recommended to bring their own laptop and proper adapters to D-sub 15 pins connector if necessary. Room staff will be ready to help you with the presentation.

Other presentations 15 min (including discussion)



Poster Presentation

- 1. Poster sessions will be held from 12:30 to 14:30 on Sep. 8 (Tue.) and 10 (Thu.) at Mielparque Kyoto in the 7F-Orion room on the 7th floor.
- 2. The poster board size is 180 cm high and 90 cm wide (portrait format). Please note that a poster prepared in landscape format cannot be displayed.
- 3. Posters should be set up on the boards with designated poster numbers from 10:00 to 12:00 on the assigned day. Push-pins will be provided to mount the posters.


- 4. Posters with odd numbers should be presented from 12:30 to 13:30 and those with even numbers should be from 13:30 to 14:30.

Access Map




Floor Plan
